2022 Georgia Peanut Calendar Photo Contest
Terms & Conditions

The Georgia Peanut Commission is hosting a photo contest May 12-Oct. 1, 2021, to fill the pages of the 2022 Georgia Peanut Calendar. This competition allows farmers to share the activities involved in peanut farming, seasons, triumphs and disappointments related to Georgia's official crop. The winning photos will capture the spirit of agriculture and give a glimpse into life on a peanut farm.

Eligibility: The contest is open to any Georgia peanut farmer or amateur photographer who has permission to photograph a Georgia peanut farm.

Contest Rules: All photos must highlight Georgia peanut production and have been taken in 2020 and/or 2021. Each entrant may enter up to three photos; however, only those of highest quality will be considered. All digital photos must be taken horizontally and in a jpeg format. Photos will be judged on the use of angle, lighting, balance, color, contrast, viewpoint and technical ability. All photos become the property of the Georgia Peanut Commission and may be used for any purpose, such as publishing in print media, posting on GPC's website and social platforms or any other promotional use. The Georgia Peanut Commission has the final decision on any and all questions or concerns regarding rules, judging, eligibility, prizes awarded or anything else that may arise pertaining to the photo contest.

Prize: A total of 13 winners will be selected. Twelve for the inside of the calendar and one additional for the calendar cover. Each of the 13 winners will be entered for a chance to win Visa gift card.
