Peanut Research Project – Ben Hill On-Farm Peanut Variety Trial 2024

Objective

During the 2023 production season we repeated a peanut variety trial with grower cooperator Kenny Ray Davis. This trial has been done with this grower since the 2020 growing season. This trial compared seven varieties in replicated treatments. The objective was to plan, conduct, complete, and share the information from this on-farm large-plot peanut trial with local and state producers.

During the growing season data was collected from the trial. Vigor rating for seed germination, stand counts, TSWV ratings, and yield data was collected from the plot. This data will give growers and specialist more details on how well the different varieties perform based on different locations and conditions.

In 2023 we were able to host a field day at the trial location for producers and industry from Ben Hill and surrounding counties. UGA specialists attended and gave the latest harvest updates and control recommendations on weeds, insects, disease, and harvest. The onsite field day gives producers a chance to see different varieties side by side with practices similar to what they implement on their own farms. At the county peanut production meeting results from the trial are shared with producers in Ben Hill counties as well as producers from all over the state.
